



Fig.1 Maximum permissible continuous forward current as a function of soldering point temperature.




Fig.2 Forward current as a function of forward voltage.




Fig.3 Maximum permissible non-repetitive peak forward current as a function of pulse duration.




Fig.4 Reverse current as a function of junction temperature.





Fig.5 Diode capacitance as a function of reverse voltage; typical values.


